1. **BEEF SALAD** Grilled beef seasoned with spicy lime dressing, lemongrass, mint leaves, onions and cucumbers. Served on a bed of lettuce.
2. **BARBECUED HONEY CHICKEN** Chicken marinated with honey and Thai herbs. Served with sweet and sour sauce. (includes steamed jasmine rice and a small salad)
3. **SEE-EW VEGETABLES** Sauteed rice noodles with assorted vegetables and soy sauce. This is vegetarian. If you wish, this can also be prepared with chicken, beef or pork.
4. **PA-NANG BEEF** Sauteed beef with red chili paste and coconut milk. Served on sliced zucchini. Served with steamed jasmine rice.

DIRECTIONS TO SIAM PALACE restaurant:

Siam Palace is on the west side of Foothill Blvd. between A and B streets. Parking is available behind the restaurant, which can be accessed by either A or B streets.

From the East: Go west on A street. Turn Left on Foothill. Pass the restaurant, turn right on B street. Turn right into the public parking lot. Siam Palace has an entrance from the parking lot, which is easy to locate.
